

## 1<sup>st</sup> Term Clothing & Bottle Drive

We need your help for a fund raising event we plan to hold at the end of each term during the school year.

Our 1<sup>st</sup> Clothing & Bottle Drive will be held during the week of Dec 14.

If any of you have ever been in Scouts or Guides (or similar organizations) you're probably aware of how this works. We will be putting together some info on how these types of fundraisers work as well as some basic Pacific Spirit School/New Learning Society facts. This way, we'll all understand what we've been asked to do and also be able to provide consistent messages about the school when asked.

Between now and Dec 14, we'd like you to drop off used clothing and housewares as well as refundable bottles. The location for your donations is the entrance to the west meeting room adjacent the main west entrance to the building. You'll see signs. You can drop off clothing and bottles any time you wish between now and Dec 14.

Then, on the evening of Wed. Dec 16 (6-8 pm) we will conduct a house-to-house clothing and bottle drive. We also need volunteers during the week of Dec 7 to drop off flyers in the neighbourhood in which we will be canvassing. The neighbourhood has not yet been chosen but you will be notified within the next month. Please let us know as soon as possible if you can do the flyer drop off or the door-to-door drive as soon as possible.

Here's a list of clothing and housewares we can collect:

Craft supplies	Pillows

We receive \$2/bag for up to 150 bags and \$3/bag for 151 and more bags. A bag is defined as a large green or black garbage bag approximately 36"x 26".

Bottles yield 5c for juice boxes, pop cans and water bottles, 10c for liquor bottles of any size and 40c for large juice containers.

Let's see how much money we can raise for the school!
